Year 11 Mock Results Day

This will take place on Tuesday 14th January during our morning registration/assembly time from 8.45am. Students will complete the process, as per the summer, where they will collect their named envelope containing their mock grades. The style of results paper will also be the same as the summer so that they understand the process and expectations.

During this collection and reflection time, students will be allowed access to their phones should they want to take photos, send messages or call you to discuss. Normal rules regarding phones will resume when they return to lesson 1 a little later than usual at 9.10am.

Revision timetable for term 3, 4 and Easter Holidays

To further support your child, our timetabled revision sessions will be starting from Tuesday 14th January also. These sessions run from 3-4pm on every available day. Most sessions are available for any student to attend, although a few sessions are invite only due to the content being covered and the specifics needed for certain students. If your child is invited to a session via ClassCharts, the expectation is that they attend and are therefore compulsory, other sessions are at the student's discretion. All attendance at sessions is acknowledged with positive ClassCharts points that can be exchanged in the reward shop.
