Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to briefly explain our approach to student equipment and to share an update following parent feedback.

As part of our behaviour and learning expectations, students are given an equipment mark on each occasion they attend school without the correct equipment required for their lessons. When a student reaches three equipment marks, they are issued with a 40-minute detention. This system is in place to encourage good organisation and ensure all students are fully prepared to learn.

We have recently taken time to listen carefully to feedback from parents and carers regarding this process. In response, we will be resetting all current equipment marks, and all students will make a fresh start from the beginning of Term 5. Please remind your child that if they do have any equipment missing, they can collect all required equipment each day, for free from our student leaders in the entrance area.

We would like to thank parents and carers for their feedback and for their continued support in helping ensure their child arrives at school prepared each day with the correct equipment. This partnership is vital in supporting students to develop responsibility and positive learning habits.
