Year 7 Parents' Evening – Thursday 6th Match 2025

We would like to invite you to attend our Year 7 Parents' Evening to be held on Thursday 6th March 2025. As a school, we place great value on the communication with our parents/carers and students. ClassCharts is our tool for doing this on a daily basis with staff adding 'points' for attitude and behaviour in and out of lessons, as well as homework completion and its quality. You will have also received a Review Point in November and this evening is the next opportunity for you to discuss your child's progress since then. We encourage students to attend with you so that they are part of the conversation about their progress in school.

We are pleased that we can offer this event physically in school, in person with your child's teachers. Appointments can be made via our School Cloud appointment booking software. The system opens at 7.30pm on Tuesday 15th February and will close on Wednesday 5th March at midnight. Appointments will be available between **4pm and 6.30pm** and all appointments are **5 minutes** in length. To ensure as many parents/carers/students can see as many staff as possible, we would ask you to **make one appointment per teacher if your child has the same teacher for two different subjects**. The staff member will be able to prioritize the discussion points, where needed, in the time available if this is the case. If you are unable to attend this evening, we would also ask you let us know this through the School Cloud system.

A short guide on how to make appointments is included with this letter. All log in information is based on the details we hold on our system. The most common error is the incorrect title used such as Miss/Mrs/Ms. Please note you will only be able to make appointments for teachers your child is taught by, however you still may see all events listed once logged in.

We look forward to seeing you on the 6th March and ask that if driving to event you are considerate of our neighbours when parking.
