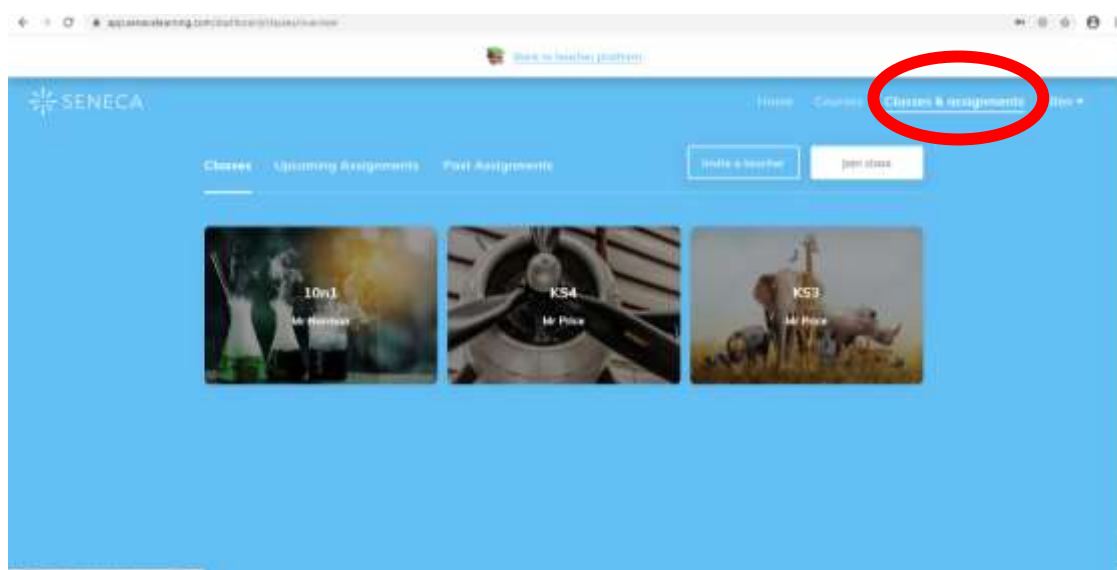
### Log in

Your teacher may have set you an assignment to complete. If so, then click '**upcoming assignments**' and you will see the task to complete.

If your teacher has not set any specific work, and you are using Seneca to revise then you should click on your class picture and choose the course (biology, physics, chemistry, KS3 science) you want to study.

Once you have done that, you will see a list of topics you can study on the left hand side of the page, as in the picture on the next page. Choose the topic you want to study, choose the subtopic, click '**start learning**' and get going!
