YEAR 6/7 TRANSITION

OUR TRANSITION PROGRAMME IS Designed to make the change from Primary to secondary school as Enjoyable and as smooth as possible.

- We visit every Year 6 student during the summer term to speak to their teachers and find out about them as individuals.
- We hold a Discovery Day during the summer term for Year 6 when students come to Maidenhill, try out a variety of lessons and meet some of their new teachers.
- We establish a strong link with parents by welcoming them to an Information Evening in July, and then again in September when our Year 7 students have been with us for a few weeks.
- Our Year 11 Student Leaders play an important part in supporting students during their first days at Maidenhill.
- As well as academic parents' evenings, we hold a special 'meet the tutor' evening for parents of Year 7 students in the autumn term.
