Route Description: Route 6

From: Start at The Red Lion at Arlingham continue on Passage Road and Arlingham Road to Frampton-on-Severn; unclassified road (Whitminster Lane) via Oatfield & Wheatenhurst to Whitminster; A38 (southbound) to Claypits Junction; unclassified road to Eastington; Bath Road to Frocester & Leonard Stanley; the High Street, Kings Stanley; unclassified road Church Street, St Georges to A419 to B4008 Bath Road, Stonehouse; Old Gloucester Road; Kings Road to Maidenhill School.

Return: Maidenhill School via reverse route of the above.

IMPORTANT – NEED TO OBTAIN BUS PASS

We have been advised from GCC Integrated Transport Unit, that from September students will no longer be able to pay a fare to the driver.

Parent/Carers will need to purchase a spare seat pass through Gloucestershire County Council by going to www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/spareseat

If students do not have a pass, they cannot travel on the bus.

The reason is because registered services need to operate with a PSVAR compliant vehicle. Due to the numbers of entitled students on this route and the non-entitled students, Ebley Coaches cannot provide a large enough compliant vehicle.

By parent buying a pass from GCC, they are able to use a 70 seat coach solving the problem, but it does mean students will no longer be able to pay a fare to the driver.
